I. INTRODUCTION & GENERAL INFORMATION

The purpose of this solicitation is to enter into a purchase agreement for condiments, spices, and staples for school cafeterias for the period beginning October 1, 2026 through September 30, 2027 with a one (1) year renewal option upon mutual consent of both parties and School Board approval. The one (1) year renewal option shall be in effect for the period of October 1, 2027 through September 30, 2028. This solicitation is for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and Summer Food Service Program (SFSP). All terms and conditions of the agreement shall remain in effect for the entire term(s) of this agreement. The District does not pay fuel adjustment charges. Food deliveries will be shipped to the ECSD Central Warehouse, 51 E Texar Drive, Pensacola, FL 32503. The quantities and delivery dates listed herein are the best estimate of the District based on prior and projected usage. The District will make every attempt to adhere as closely as possible to the estimated quantities. However, the District reserves the right to adjust the number of shipments and/or purchase additional quantities at the contract price at any time during the contract period.

Any Addenda issued concerning this ITB will be posted on the BidNet Direct website at <https://www.bidnetdirect.com/florida>. **PRIOR TO SUBMITTING A BID**, it shall be the sole responsibility of each bidder to contact the Procurement Specialist or visit the BidNet Direct website to determine if an Addendum has been issued and to obtain such Addendum.

For the Escambia County School District (ECSD) to ensure equal treatment of all participating vendors, the above named individual is ECSD's only designated representative for this Bid. Vendors are expected to utilize this representative for **ALL** Information regarding this Bid. Vendors who contact any other District employee regarding the subject of this bid are subject to disqualification from participating in this Bid.

- II. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:** The term "Bidder, Responder, Vendor, Respondent, or Contractor" as used within this Invitation to Bid (ITB) refers to the person, company or organization responding to this ITB. The Bidder is responsible for understanding and complying with the terms and conditions herein.
- A. GENERAL:** Upon award of this ITB, the resulting Contract, or any portion thereof, may, upon mutual written agreement of the parties, be extended for an additional term(s) or for additional quantities. All original terms and conditions shall remain in effect during any approved extension. Subject to the mutual consent of the parties, the pricing, terms, and conditions of this ITB for the products or services specified herein may be extended to other municipal, city, or county government agencies, school boards, community or state colleges, or state universities within the State of Florida.
- B. BID OPENING AND FORM:** Bid openings will be public on the date and time specified on the Bidder's Acknowledgement form. All bids received after the time indicated will be rejected as non-responsive and retained by the District. Bids by Email, fax, telegram, or verbally by telephone or in person will not be accepted. The public opening will acknowledge receipt of the bid only; details concerning pricing or the offering will not be announced. All bids submitted shall become public record upon an announcement of a recommended award or thirty (30) days after the opening date whichever occurs first. To protect any confidential information contained in their bids, companies must invoke the exemptions to disclosure provided by law in response to the ITB, and must identify the data and other material to be protected, and must state the reasons why such exclusion from public disclosure is necessary.
- C. WARRANTY:** All goods and services furnished by the Bidder pursuant to this ITB shall be warranted to meet or exceed the specifications contained herein. In the event of a breach of warranty or failure

to comply with the specifications, the Bidder shall take all necessary corrective action, at the Bidder's expense, to remedy such breach in the most expeditious manner possible.

- D. PRICING:** All prices submitted shall include all packaging, handling, shipping, freight, and delivery charges to any location within Escambia County, Florida, including inside delivery where required. The School Board is exempt and does not pay Federal Excise and State of Florida Sales taxes.
- E. TERMS OF PAYMENT/INVOICING:** Payment terms should be Net 30 Days from receipt and acceptance of goods or services, and Bidder's invoice. Itemized invoices, each bearing the applicable Purchase Order Number, should be submitted to Accounts Payable on the day of shipment. Invoices subject to cash discounts should be submitted to Accounts Payable on the date they are issued.
- F. TRANSPORTATION AND TITLE:**
1. Title to the goods will pass to the School District upon receipt and acceptance at the destination indicated herein. Until acceptance, the Bidder retains the sole insurable interest in the goods.
 2. The shipper will prepay all transportation charges. The school District will not accept collect freight charges.
 3. No premium carriers will be used for the School District's account without prior written consent of the Procurement Director.
- G. PACKAGING:** All shipments will include an itemized list of each package's content, and reference the School District's Purchase Order Number. No charges will be allowed for cartage or packing unless agreed upon by the School District prior to shipment.
- H. INSPECTIONS AND TESTING:** The School District will have the right to expedite, inspect and test any of the goods or work covered by this Bid. All goods or services are subject to the School District's inspection and approval upon arrival or completion. If rejected, they will be held for disposal at the Bidder's risk. Such inspection, or the waiver thereof, however, will not relieve the Bidder from full responsibility for furnishing goods or work conforming to the requirements of this Bid or the Bid Specifications, and will not prejudice any claim, right, or privilege the School District may have because of the use of defective or unsatisfactory goods or work.
- I. STOP WORK ORDER:** The School District may at any time by written notice to the Bidder stop all or any part of the work for this Bid award. Upon receiving such notice, the Bidder will take all reasonable steps to minimize additional costs during the period of work stoppage. The School District may subsequently either cancel the stop work order resulting in an equitable adjustment in the delivery schedule and/or the price, or terminate the work in accordance with the provisions of the Bid terms and conditions.
- J. INSURANCE AND INDEMNIFICATION:** The Bidder agrees to indemnify and save harmless the School District, its officers, agents and employees from and against any and all claims and liabilities (including expenses) for injury or death of persons or damage to any property which may result, in whole or in part, from any act or omission on the part of the Bidder, its agents, employees, or representatives, or are arising from any Bidder furnished goods or services, except to the extent that such damage is due solely and directly to the negligence of the School District. The Bidder will carry comprehensive general liability insurance, including contractual and product liability coverage, with minimum limits acceptable to the School District. The Bidder will, at the request of the School

District, supply certificates evidencing such coverage.

K. RISK OF LOSS: The Bidder assumes the following risks:

1. All risks of loss or damage to all goods, work in process, materials and equipment until the delivery thereof as herein provided
2. All risks of loss or damage to third persons and their property until delivery of all goods as herein provided
3. All risks of loss or damage to any property received by the Bidder or held by the Bidder or its suppliers for the account of the School District, until such property has been delivered to the School District
4. All risks of loss or damage to any of the goods or part thereof rejected by the School District, from the time of shipment thereof to Bidder until redelivery thereof to the School District.

L. LAWS AND REGULATIONS: Bidders will comply with all applicable Federal, State and Local laws, statutes and ordinances including, but not limited to the rules, regulations and standards of the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970, the Federal Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, and the rules and regulations promulgated under these Acts. Bidders agree not to discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, sex, religion, color, age or national origin. All agreements as a result of an award hereto and all extensions and modifications thereto and all questions relating to its validity, interpretation, performance or enforcement shall be governed and construed in conformance to the laws of the State of Florida.

M. PUBLIC ENTITY CRIMES: A Bidder, person, or affiliate who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit a Bid on a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work, may not submit a Bid on leases of real property to a public entity, may not be awarded or perform work as a contractor, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a contract with any public entity, and may not transact business with any public entity in excess of the threshold amount provided in Florida State Statute, Section 287.017, for CATEGORY TWO for a period of 36 months from the date of being placed on the convicted vendor list.

N. PATENTS: Bidders agree to indemnify and save harmless the School District, its officers, employees, agents, or representatives using the goods specified herein from any loss, damage or injury arising out of a claim or suit at law or equity for actual or alleged infringement of letters of patent by reason of the buying, selling or using the goods supplied under this Bid, and will assume the defense of any and all suits and will pay all costs and expenses thereto.

O. CONFLICT OF INTEREST: The award hereunder is subject to the provisions of Chapter 112 Florida Statutes. All Bidders must disclose the name of any company owner, officer, director or agent who is an employee of the School District and/or is an employee of the School District and owns, directly or indirectly, an interest of five percent or more of the company.

P. TERMINATION:

1. **DEFAULT:** The School District may terminate all or any part of a subsequent award by giving notice of default to Bidder, if Bidder:
 - a) Refuses or fails to deliver the goods or services within the time specified;

- b) Fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Bid or so fails to make progress as to endanger performances, hereunder, or;
- c) Becomes insolvent or subject to proceedings under any law relating to bankruptcy, insolvency, or relief of debtors. In the event of termination for default, the School District's liability will be limited to the payment for goods and services delivered and accepted as of the date of termination.

2. CONVENIENCE: The School District may terminate for its convenience at any time, in whole or in part any subsequent award. In which event of termination for convenience, the School District's sole obligations will be to reimburse the Bidder for;

- a) Those goods or services actually shipped/performed and accepted up to the date of termination, and;
- b) Costs incurred by the Bidder for unfinished goods, which are specifically manufactured for the School District and which are not standard products of the Bidders, as of the date of termination, and a reasonable profit thereon. In no event is the School District responsible for loss of anticipated profit nor will reimbursement exceed the Bid value.

Q. DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE: Whenever two or more Bids are equal with respect to price, quality, and service, an Bid received from a business that certifies that it has implemented a drug-free workplace program as defined by Section 287.087 Florida Statutes, will be given preference in the award process.

R. PERFORMANCE: In an effort to reduce the cost of doing business with the School District, and unless indicated elsewhere, no Bid or performance bond is required. However, upon award and subsequent default by the Bidder, the School District reserves the right to pursue any or all of the following remedies:

- 1. To accept the next lowest available Bid price or to purchase materials or services on the open market, and to charge the original awardees for the difference in cost via a deduction to any outstanding or future obligations;
- 2. The Bidder in default will be prohibited from activity for a period of time determined by the severity of the default, but not exceeding two years;
- 3. Any other remedy available to the School District in tort or law.

S. AUDIT AND INSPECTION: The District or its representative reserves the right to inspect and/or audit all the Bidder's documents and records as they pertain to the products and services delivered under this agreement. Such rights will be exercised with notice to the Bidder to determine compliance with and performance of the terms, conditions and specifications on all matters, rights and duties, and obligations established by this agreement. Documents/records in any form shall be open to the District's representative and may include but are not limited to all correspondence, ordering, payment, inspection and receiving records, and contracts or sub-contracts that directly or indirectly pertain to the transactions between the District and the Bidder.

T. SAMPLES AND BRAND NAMES:

- 1. **SAMPLES:** Any sample required by this Bid or submitted at the Bidder's option shall be

forwarded under separate cover to the Escambia County School District Central Warehouse. The package or container shall clearly reference the Bid number, Bid title, and applicable item number and be marked "SAMPLES." All samples shall be provided at no cost to the School District, including all shipping and transportation charges. Bidders are responsible for notifying the School District and making arrangements for the pickup of samples if their return is desired. Any samples not claimed within thirty (30) days following award or completion of the evaluation process may be disposed of at the sole discretion of the School District.

2. BRAND NAMES: Specifications referencing specific brand names and models are intended to describe the type and quality of materials, workmanship, and performance that the School District expects to receive at a minimum. Bidders offering an alternate product to the referenced brand/model shall:

- a) Identify the manufacturer's name, brand name, model number, and/or part number in the space provided within the Bid.
- b) Indicate "ALT" next to the proposed price to identify an alternate offering.
- c) Provide sufficient technical specifications, product literature, and supporting documentation to enable the School District to conduct a preliminary evaluation when a sample is not submitted with the Bid.
- d) Upon request by the School District, provide a sample, trial product, or product demonstration, as deemed appropriate by the School District, at no cost to the District.

3. The School District reserves the sole right to determine the acceptability of any alternate product offered.

U. DOCUMENTATION FOR MEAL PATTERN REQUIREMENTS: All Bids will include documentation for child nutrition meal pattern requirements. The submission of any or all of the following documents pertains to all Bid's, including those that already appear as an approved brand.

1. Child Nutrition (CN) Statement
2. Product specifications detailing the nutrition content
3. Product Formulation Statement.

V. EVALUATION GUIDELINES: Any product offered that is not listed as an approved item in the Specifications and Pricing Section, VIII, must be tested.

1. Primary factors used to determine awards under this ITB will be Price, quality, availability, and responsiveness. Other factors that may be considered during the evaluation process include:
 - a) Administrative costs incurred by the School District in association with the administration of any resulting contract
 - b) Alternative payment terms
 - c) The Bidder's past performance with the School District or other comparable entities.
2. The School District reserves the right to evaluate Bids by group, category, line item, or in their

entirety; to accept or reject any Bid, in whole or in part; and to waive minor irregularities when such action is determined to be in the best interest of the School District. In the event of a discrepancy between the unit price and the extended price, the unit price shall govern.

3. The School District shall have sole discretion in determining evaluation and testing methods, including product reviews, sample evaluations, and taste tests, where applicable.

4. Award may be made on either of the following bases:

a) **Line Item Award:** Award for each line item may be made to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder offering a product listed on the approved products list. When an alternate product is offered, award may be made only after the product has been tested and approved by the School District in accordance with the sample requirements of this ITB. The School District reserves the right to reject any bid containing minimum shipment requirements. A bid containing minimum shipment requirements shall receive consideration only if such requirements are accepted by the School District.

b) **Lot Award:** Award may be made on an aggregate low-price basis for all line items within a similar or compatible lot. For example, all rice products may be awarded as a single lot to one (1) Bidder.

5. The School District may also consider products, services, and pricing available through contracts awarded by state, federal, and local governmental agencies, cooperative purchasing organizations, and other Florida school districts. The School District reserves the right to make award(s) in the manner determined to be in its best interest and in accordance with applicable law and the requirements of this ITB.

W. CLARIFICATIONS AND INTERPRETATIONS: The School District reserves the right to allow for clarification of questionable entries, and for the Bidder to withdraw items with obvious mistakes. Any questions concerning terms, conditions or specifications will be directed to the designated Procurement Specialist referenced on the Bid Acknowledgement. Any ambiguities or inconsistencies shall be brought to the attention of the designated Procurement Specialist in writing at least seven workdays prior to the opening date of the Bids. Failure to do so, on the part of the Bidder will constitute an acceptance by the Bidder of a consequent decision. An addendum to the Bid shall be issued and posted for those interpretations that may affect the eventual outcome of this Bid. It is the Bidder's responsibility to assure the receipt of all addenda issued. No person is authorized to give oral interpretations of, or make oral changes to the Bid. Therefore, oral statements given before the Bid opening date will not be binding. The School District will consider no interpretations binding unless provided for by issuance of an addendum. Addenda will be posted to the BidNet Direct website address at <https://www.bidnetdirect.com/florida> at least five workdays prior to the opening date. The Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of all addenda by signing and enclosing said addenda with their Bid.

X. BID TABULATIONS, RECOMMENDATIONS, AND PROTEST: Bid tabulations with award recommendations are posted for 72 hours in the Procurement Office and are also posted to the Bid Net Direct website address at: <https://bidnetdirect.com/florida>. Failure to file a protest within the time prescribed in Section 120.57(3) Florida State Statutes or failure to post the bond or other security required by law within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, Florida State Statutes. Bid tabulations, recommendations, or notices will not be

automatically mailed.

- Y. CONTACT:** All questions regarding this Bid must be directed to the designated Procurement Specialist noted on page one. Prospective Bidders shall not contact any member of the Escambia County School Board, Superintendent, or staff regarding this Bid prior to posting of the final tabulation and award recommendation. Any other such contact may be cause for rejection of your Bid.
 - Z. BID PREPARATION COSTS:** Neither the School District nor its representatives shall be liable for any expenses incurred in connection with the preparation of a response to this Bid.
 - AA. AGREEMENT FORM:** All subsequent agreements as a result of an award hereunder, shall incorporate all terms, conditions and specifications contained herein, and in response hereto, unless mutually amended in writing.
 - BB. MODIFICATIONS:** Changes to specifications, terms, and conditions must be in writing and be by mutual consent of both parties and School Board approval, if needed.
- III. SPECIAL CONDITIONS:** These "SPECIAL CONDITIONS" are in addition to or supplement Section II GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS. In the event of a conflict these SPECIAL CONDITIONS shall have precedence.
- A. EX-PARTE COMMUNICATION:** Ex parte communication, whether verbal or written, by any potential Bidders or representative of any potential Bidders to this solicitation with District personnel involved with or related to this Bid, other than as expressly designated in this document, is strictly prohibited. Violation of this restriction may result in the rejection/disqualification of the Bidders' offer. Ex parte communication (whether verbal or written) by any potential Bidder or representative of any potential Bidder to this solicitation with District Board members is also prohibited and will result in the disqualification of the Bidder. **Any current vendor meetings with District staff and administration, or instructional personnel shall at no time include any conversation regarding the Bid. Any current contractor meetings with District staff and administration, or instructional personnel shall at no time include any conversation regarding the Bid.**
 - B. DOCUMENTATION AND REQUIRED ENCLOSURES:** All documents listed below must be returned in their entirety. **Failure to return all pages (entire document) or any of the items listed below may result in your Bid not being accepted.**
 - 1. The entire Bid document (pages 1 – 114).** The signature on the first page must be an original or electronic signature – no fax or email documents will be accepted. In the event that the Bidder makes an error on entering any information and enters a correction, the change(s) must be initialed. Any Bid submitted with strike over or white out corrections that are not initialed will be rejected as non-responsive.
 - 2. Return your original Bid and one copy.** The copy should be a photocopy of your original Bid and there should be no differences in the Bid document or attached enclosures. Any difference or failure to include Bid attachments in both sets may cause your Bid to be rejected. **Please mark the copy "COPY." Bid documents may be printed double-sided with left margin, book-style binding.** If submitting an electronic Bid submission, provide only one completed document including all pages and attachments required for the Bid submission. No copy needs to be provided.

3. Product specification sheets or certifications must be attached if requested for an item in the Specifications and Pricing Section and/or if offering alternate items. **If documents were sent with sample products, they should also be attached with your Bid document.**
4. **DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE:** While it is not required, this form will be a determining factor in evaluating an award between two (2) offers equal in price, quality, and service. Refer to (Attachment A). Failure to return this form may result in your Bid not being accepted.
5. **CERTIFICATE REGARDING DEBARMENT, SUSPENSION, INELIGIBILITY, AND VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION:** This form (Attachment B) must be signed and returned with your Bid. Failure to return this form will result in your Bid not being accepted.
6. **REFERENCE RELEASE FORM (NO. P-002):** If not currently doing business with the Escambia County School District (ECSD), three (3) commercial clients or other School Districts similar to ECSD must be submitted. Refer to (Attachment C). Failure to return this form may result in your Bid not being accepted.
7. **USDA CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT PRICE DETERMINATION:** This form (Attachment D) must be signed and returned with your Bid. Failure to return this form may result in your Bid not being accepted.

1. Any alternate packaging offered must be substantially equivalent to the packaging specified and must be clearly identified as an alternate bid.

V. ORDER PLACEMENT AND DELIVERY PROCEDURES:

A. ORDERING PROCEDURES: Individual cafeterias shall not place orders directly with the awarded Bidder. All orders for items awarded under this ITB shall be issued by the Procurement Office of the School District of Escambia County. Any additions, deletions, modifications, or other changes to existing orders must also be authorized and issued through the Procurement Office.

B. SHIPPING/RECEIVING REQUIREMENTS:

1. All merchandise shipped in quantities of fifty (50) cases or more shall be palletized on 48" x 40" grocery pallets. The maximum pallet height shall be sixty-eight (68) inches, measured from the bottom of the pallet to the top of the stacked product. 3. All shelf-stable products delivered to the ECSD Warehouse shall have a minimum remaining shelf life of six (6) months at the time of delivery. Best-by dates shall be clearly marked on the side of each case or pallet.

a) **NOTE:** Failure to comply with these delivery requirements may result in refusal of the shipment and the District shall not be responsible for any additional costs, including but not limited to freight, shipping, handling, storage, or restocking fees.

C. DESTINATION INSPECTION: Final acceptance of all products shall be made by the consignee at the point of delivery. The consignee may reject:

1. Products that are not identified with the appropriate "USDA Accepted as Specified" stamp.
2. Products that bear the appropriate stamp but exhibit obvious or material deviations from specification requirements. Products certified by USDA that, in the opinion of the consignee, contain deviations that do not materially affect usability may be tentatively accepted pending verification by local USDA grading personnel. Any deviations identified at delivery shall be promptly reported to USDA personnel for investigation.

D. CONDITION OF PRODUCT AT TIME OF DELIVERY: The Contractor shall ensure that refrigerated vehicles are used when required to protect products during transportation and that all transportation practices comply with applicable HACCP (Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point) requirements and food safety regulations. Upon delivery, all products shall comply with the applicable specifications and shall be subject to inspection by the consignee for cleanliness, condition, and wholesomeness.

E. DELIVERY EQUIPMENT (FROZEN FOOD): The successful Bidder and/or its carrier shall utilize properly insulated, mechanically refrigerated, and thermostatically controlled equipment. F.
